

# Connecting Cambridgeshire Digital Connectivity Programme Overview



## Superfast broadband (24mbps +)

- 97% of homes & businesses reached early 2019
- Rollout aiming for >99% by 2021
- Universal Service Obligation (USO) for 1% remaining



## Public Access Wi-Fi

- Free CambWifi in >200 public buildings and open spaces
- Expanding Wifi to market towns and village halls
- Supporting digital inclusion activities



## Mobile 2G - 4G

- Working with mobile operators to improve poor coverage affecting businesses and communities
- Targeting Top 20 'partial notspots' identified through detailed surveys
- Seeking Government investment through Shared Rural Networks



## Full Fibre

- Aiming for 30% full fibre coverage by 2022
- Using Fibre to the Premise (FTTP) to bring gigabit speeds
- Developing fibre assets and connecting public buildings



## Smart Programme

- Using technology and data to develop smart solutions
- Helping to tackle challenges such as transport and air quality
- Exploring next generation connectivity to support market towns growth
