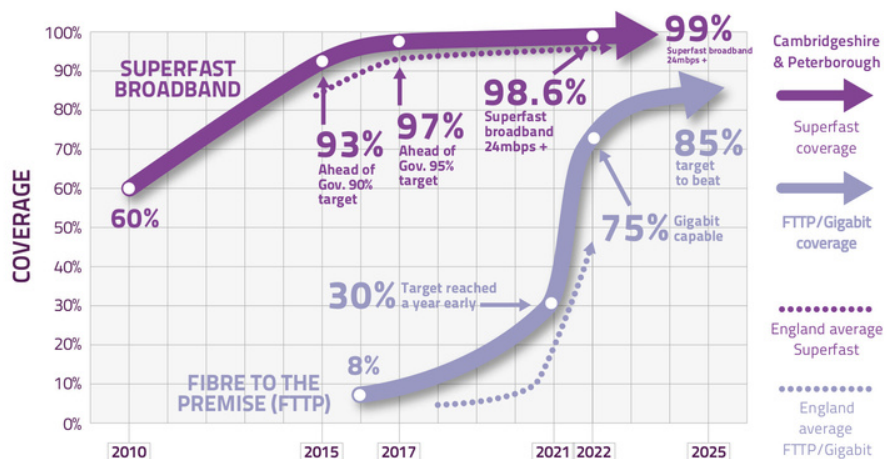

Broadband



Both superfast and full fibre broadband coverage in Cambridgeshire & Peterborough are above the national average and ahead of Government targets. However, work is ongoing to bring future-proof connectivity to homes and businesses in harder-to-reach areas.



Project Gigabit

The Government's BDUK programme is due to announce which broadband supplier will be awarded the Project Gigabit contract, to extend gigabit-capable full fibre coverage to >45,000 harder-to-reach premises in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough.

Gigabit broadband vouchers

Government Gigabit Vouchers of £4,500 together with top-ups of £1,500 (funded by CPCA) will be available to cover the cost of installing fibre broadband for eligible groups of rural premises that aren't in commercial plans or covered by Project Gigabit. We'll be engaging directly with businesses and residents in eligible areas to encourage take-up of this funding where possible.

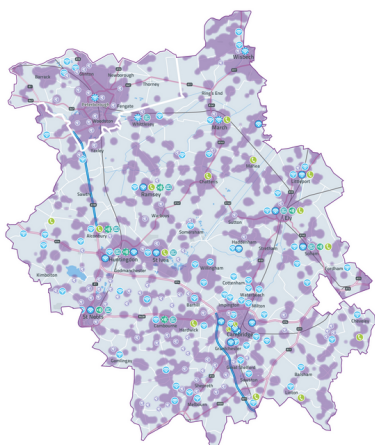
Members update

District Digital Overviews

Connecting Cambridgeshire works closely with city/district councils to keep Members and officers updated on the progress of the digital infrastructure strategy and the digital connectivity issues for their area.

District Digital Overviews have been developed to provide a one-page summary of digital coverage data for each area to support local digital strategies and help to define digital priorities.

Broadband suppliers in your area?



Communities are seeing increasing numbers of fibre broadband providers actively rolling out gigabit capable fibre networks in our area. The Connecting Cambridgeshire team is working with suppliers and council teams to support and encourage this investment, however, because of the highly competitive market, commercial rollout plans are rarely announced ahead of delivery and may change at short notice.

Most suppliers actively engage with communities before build work starts - usually by letter - but this can raise questions from residents, especially as different fibre providers may share the same sub-contractors. We are talking regularly to providers to ensure proactive community engagement and we encourage any Members, residents or businesses with questions or concerns to contact us.

Mobile coverage



Connecting Cambridgeshire is working with local authorities and mobile network operators (MNOs) looking to invest in 4G and 5G networks to improve coverage and capacity, which will have a long-term economic impact for the area.

This includes commissioning local surveys to understand areas of poor mobile connectivity, data analysis of planning applications for mobile masts and the appointment of digital connectivity planning officers to liaise with MNOs.

Local mobile surveys



Additional detailed mobile phone coverage testing is currently underway to update previous survey work and highlight coverage issues. The results will be analysed and shared in due course.
