	2. We will help everyone get ready for the <b>Digital</b> Switchover by 31st January 2027.
2027	The <b>Digital Switchover</b> is when all telephones will change to use the internet.
Fair, Strong, Connected Communities	3. We are working with the Cambridge Council for Voluntary Service to build the Cambridgeshire Digital Partnership.
	We will hold meetings and talks about digital inclusion in Cambridgeshire.
PETERBOROUGH CITY COUNCIL	<b>4.</b> We will work with Peterborough City Council and other groups to make sure everyone in Peterborough has digital support.

	7. We will find people who can be <b>Digital</b> Champions.  A <b>Digital Champion</b> is someone who helps make digital inclusion a part of local services.
	8. We will work with volunteers to support digital inclusion across the county.
